

Bocce

For those who are new to the game of Bocce, there will be a lesson and demonstration on Sunday April 21, 2013 at 6:00 PM. Experienced players are especially welcomed to be on hand to show the newbies the fine points of the game and to get in a few practice throws before the official Camelot Bocce Ball season starts on **Friday, April 26, 2013.**

Remember that this year matches will get underway every Friday at 6:00 PM.

We hope to create a league for a four week Camelot Bocce tournament with two short rounds of play each Friday night in May. Teams will be composed of two or four players depending on the level of interest. **It doesn't matter if you have never played the game before. It's easy to learn, easy to play** and a nice way to spend time with other people in the neighborhood. Bring a beach chair to the courts because there are only three benches.

A number of people have shown an interest in playing this year so I am hoping to see some new faces on the courts.

Also, beginning in June, we are organizing a four week tournament with two other nearby 55+ active communities, Country Gardens and Parke Place with the idea of playing a round at each location. In May I will be trying to recruit 12 men and women players for the inter-community tournament.

Bocce is a game with roots that go back to ancient times. It is a favorite recreational pastime at active adult communities throughout south Jersey. It's a light physical exertion pastime that is fun to play, encourages interaction with neighbors, strategic planning, and friendly competition.
